Manipal Academy of Higher Education (MAHE), Manipal an Institution of Eminence invites applications for the position of Research Coordinator/Associate for the research project 'MAHE Mahabharata' under the Department of Philosophy - Dvaita Philosophy Resource Centre.

'MAHE Mahabharata' Research Project (<https://mahabharata.manipal.edu>), is looking for young and enthusiastic - fulltime scholar to work on Grammatical Analysis and Subject Indexing. This project is now funded by the Astadashi – Technical Adaptation Project of the Central Sanskrit University (CSU), New Delhi (<http://www.sanskrit.nic.in/>).

'MAHE Mahabharata' has developed first-of-its-kind 'Digital Concordance' (phase I) for the three renowned critical editions of Mahabharata and the first search engine for 'Mahabharata' and its commentary 'Mahabharata-Tatparyanirnaya' during 2016-19. Since 2020, it is working on the 'Grammatical Analysis' (phase II) as well as 'Subject Indexing' (phase III) of the textual contents using Sanskrit Computational Linguistics applications.

- Literary and linguistic proficiency in Sanskrit
- Willingness to teach/assist Sanskrit language, literature and linguistics (English and Sanskrit)
- In-depth knowledge of Indian philosophy and literature
- Multidisciplinary research orientation and readiness for conference participation and publications
- Sound knowledge of computational applications and Indic scripts
- Eagerness to foster team spirit and work in multicultural environment

Qualification:

- PhD (Vidyavaridhi) or MA (Vidvat/Acharya) or any equivalent degree in Sanskrit literature and philosophy
- Preference will be given to women and experienced candidates
